Howto set MinWidth or MinHeight of a WinRT ScrollViewer

I use the ScrollViewer control in a windows 8 metro app in order to zoom in/out an image. The problem now is, that it is possible to zoom in the image untill you almost can't zoom out again(because the image gets so small). I've tried MinWidth and MinHeight on the ScrollViewer and on the image, but it didn't work. After some time i found the MinZoomFactor of the ScrollViewer, and this now works.
